<u>ABOUT THE JOB:</u> This position is for an **Assistant Tournament Director** with Anera Sports. Anera Sports, based in Dallas, TX, is the host organization for two Korn Ferry Tour events. The Veritex Bank Championship, which is preparing for its third year, and a new, soon to be announced, championship in Oklahoma City, OK (scheduled to play June 2023). **This position is based in Oklahoma City, OK.**

This **Assistant Tournament Director's** main responsibilities will lie in several managerial roles for the Oklahoma Korn Ferry Tour event. As the local on-site team leader responsibilities will focus both on the operational and sales sides of event planning. This role will include working with the Tournament Director on contract administration, vendor management including specific RFP's, volunteer liaison, as well as be expected to generate new business and handle the fulfillment associated with all sales.

<u>OPERATIONS:</u> Manage vendor relationships to include all logistical areas to support the tournament. Manage the relationship with host golf club, including food and beverage, function space, and clubhouse operations. Manage the relationship with the City of Norman, OK and University of Oklahoma to ensure permits are secured, police support is adequate, and transportation plans are approved. Work with the PGA TOUR Operations staff to ensure their on-site needs are met. This role will provide the highest level of service through constant communication and follow through while building and establishing relationships with local community organizations such as chambers of commerce and tourism boards, local leaders, and community influencers.

BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT: Ability to identify and secure sponsorship sources within the local community. Expectation is that position will solicit and secure sponsors in partnership with the current business development staff members in place. There will also be opportunities to generate sales for pro-am. Additionally, this position will aid in the development and creation of marketing materials, including website enhancements and social media.

Qualifications:

- Minimum three years of tournament or equitable experience in leadership and sales
- Proficient in Microsoft Office Suite.
- Proficient in Social Media Platforms (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.)
- Knowledge and passion for golf a plus
- Ability to work weekends, evenings, and early morning as required, along with extended schedules on and around championships weeks; some travel required
- Understanding of and commitment to the goals, standards, and expectations of Anera Sports
- Self-directed with strong work ethics; willing to be part of an entrepreneurial and growing company while playing a vital role in its growth
